

INTERIM PASTOR

Praise the Lord!! With the leading of the Holy Spirit and the guidance the congregation provided in the development of Emanuel's Mission Site Profile (MSP), the Call Team has begun their work! In partnership with the Office of the Bishop they will contact, interview, prayerfully consider and recommend to the Church Council and congregation the individual they believe God might be calling to partner with Emanuel in ministry. Upon council recommendation, the candidate is not called as pastor until the congregation votes to extend that call. Please keep this process in your prayers!

Calling a pastor to partner in ministry is certainly a pivotal moment in the life of the church. But sometimes in the excitement and anticipation of a new pastor arriving, it can be easy to forget that God doesn't only call pastors – God calls EACH AND EVERY ONE OF US to be ministers, to be partners with one another in Christ's work.

Along with Jerry and Cici Schnakenberg as well as a few hundred of our siblings in Christ, I had the privilege last week of being a part of our Pacifica Synod Assembly: "Together in Christ". The theme was rooted in Ephesians 4:1-6 where Paul writes

I therefore, the prisoner in the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of the calling to which you have been called, ²with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, ³making every effort to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. ⁴There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling, ⁵one Lord, one faith, one baptism, ⁶one God and Father of all, who is above all and through all and in all.

Through the power of the Holy Spirit God has called ALL of us, whether individuals, families, or congregations, TOGETHER IN CHRIST, to mission and service in Christ's name. Read further in Ephesians 4 to be reminded that God's grace and gifts have been given to EACH OF US "...to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ." (Ephesians 4:11-12)

At the synod assembly, Bishop Taylor invited us to especially reflect on what it might mean for us "to lead a life worthy of your calling."

The Transition Team spent months helping us talk about who Emanuel is and what God might be calling Emanuel to do and to be. Out of those conversations and from your input came this paragraph in the MSP talking about what YOU see as Emanuel's purpose, her reason for being . . .

Emanuel is here to serve the Lord and those around us. We want to be a light to the world. We are a congregation who wants to love others as Jesus loves . . . do the things that Jesus did . . . help people KNOW and EXPERIENCE God's love and the gift of being part of the family of God . . . intentionally reach out to be sure EVERYONE knows they are valued, important, welcome and included. We want to be prayerful and courageous . . . grounded in God's Word . . . and empowered by the Holy Spirit.

In these VERY challenging and troubling times, the world desperately needs each of us to be a light to the world.

How might God be calling YOU to live out your faith at home, at work, in the world?

What might it mean for YOU "to lead a life worthy of your calling"?

May we truly live out OUR calling, TOGETHER IN CHRIST, each sharing and exercising God's gifts to us in worship, in mission, in service and in prayer!

Pacifica Synod Assembly Report May 19-21



On May 19-21 we had the great honor of attending the Pacifica Synod Assembly in Irvine CA. It was a wonderful experience being in a large room filled with people doing God's work, sharing uplifting stories of how God is working through our churches to help people in need. We also heard from many organizations that the ELCA is supporting like the Agape House at SDSU in San Diego providing safe Christian housing for students. We also heard from some organizations we support here at Emanuel like Lutheran Camps.

We now have the Bishop Andy Taylor Campership Fund, which provides scholarships to young people wanting to experience Lutheran Christian Camps. See below to donate and note on the check: BAT Campership. (They call Bishop Andy Taylor BAT Man) They also had workshops on. Undoing Racism in the Church, In These Challenging Times Coaching?, Planned Giving Best Practices for Congregations and how to link them to Stewardship, (CiCi attended this one), Sharing our Faith Stories, The Tax Exempt Effect, Healthy Transitions and Congregational Constitutions (Jerry attended this one). They also talked about how important online worship is in bringing the Word to many people who can't make it to church and also bringing the Word to new people who

haven't been exposed to it. We also got to elect a new Bishop to the Pacifica Synod, Bishop David Nagler. We didn't realize that you vote up to 5 times to elect the Bishop. We also voted to elect Pacifica Synod Council members, committee members and a couple resolutions. Bishop Taylor did an excellent job keeping the Assembly moving and on track. There was also a lot of humor to keep things up beat. On the last day we had a wonderful worship service led by Bishop Taylor including Holy Communion. It was a great experience and we would recommend to everyone to go if they get the opportunity.

We would also like to give a special "Thank You" to Pastor Sandy for quiding us through this important event.

SANDY SCENES

Make a scene with this fun summer craft you can create outdoors.



- Play sand
- Spoons
- Empty jars
- Powdered tempera paint
- Cardstock paper and pencil
- Craft glue
- Paintbrush --



What you do:

- 1. Pour a few tablespoons of sand into empty jars. (You need one jar for every color of paint you make.)
- 2. Add a small amount of powdered paint to the sand and then mix. Experiment with the amount, using more paint to create deeper colors.
- 3. Lightly sketch a design on cardstock.
- 4. Working in one small section at a time, paint an even layer of craft glue on the paper.
- 5. Use a spoon to sprinkle colored sand atop the glue. Tilt the paper so extra sand falls off. Repeat to complete the entire design.
- 6. Let dry on a flat surface before displaying upright.
