How has your summer been? Vacation? Stay-cation? What did YOU do this summer?

At VBS this past Saturday those were some of the questions I heard asked between friends as many gathered in person after not seeing one another for a while. What a gift it is to 'check in' with friends. An even better gift? Taking time to 'check in' with ourselves and God!

As we enter August and prepare to soon return to our Fall routines, there are lots of mixed feelings. For some, August is a scramble to try and finish the summer projects planned way back in the Spring. Others are looking forward to Fall and getting back to familiar routines, some shaped by school and work schedules. I know teachers have already "switched gears" and have begun preparing curriculum and classroom decorations while students have begun counting down their last days of summer freedom. Wherever you "fall" this August, I hope you'll make time to slow down and savor these last days of summer, taking time to reflect on where this summer you have experienced God's love and presence and providing. How have you grown in your faith, in your relationship with God? with others?

When we're baptized, through our parents and sponsors, and, then later, at confirmation, we say "Yes" to living every day rooted in God's promise and the gift of an unending relationship of love and forgiveness and grace that God offers us. At Emanuel and in many churches confirmands are asked to write their own faith statements: a description of THEIR faith – not their parents' faith, or their friends' faith or their pastor's faith. Confirmands also choose confirmation Bible verses – passages from God's Word that help challenge and/or describe their faith. In response to God claiming us as beloved children, central to the confirmation service, we promise at confirmation to continue in that covenant, to nurture that gift of God's relationship with us . . .

- -- to live among God's faithful people (spend time with other Christians)
- -- to hear the word of God and share in the Lord's supper (worship)
- -- to proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word and deed (live out our faith)
- -- to serve all people, following Jesus' example (serving God and neighbor)
- -- to strive for justice and peace in all the earth (seek God's purpose for all)

August is a GREAT time for us to 'check in' with God and ask ourselves

- -- How am I doing in the five areas listed above that will help ME keep growing in faith?
- -- What would I say if I was writing MY faith statement?
- -- Through what Bible verse(s) might God be challenging, nurturing, describing my faith right now?
- -- How does knowing Jesus make a difference in MY life? in how I see myself? others? the world?
- -- How will I keep growing in faith?

What a gift it is that God has claimed us, adopted us AND calls us BELOVED! Not because of what we do or who we are – but because of who God is!

May all of us keep growing in knowing and experiencing and sharing Christ this summer and always!





Make a scene with this fun summer craft you can create outdoors.



- Play sand
- Spoons
- Empty jars
- Powdered tempera paint
- Cardstock paper and pencil
- Craft glue



What you do:

- 1. Pour a few tablespoons of sand into empty jars. (You need one jar for every color of paint you make.)
- 2. Add a small amount of powdered paint to the sand and then mix. Experiment with the amount, using more paint to create deeper colors.
- 3. Lightly sketch a design on cardstock.
- 4. Working in one small section at a time, paint an even layer of craft glue on the paper.
- 5. Use a spoon to sprinkle colored sand atop the glue. Tilt the paper so extra sand falls off. Repeat to complete the entire design.
- 6. Let dry on a flat surface before displaying upright.
