A NOTE FROM THE INTERIM PASTOR

PRAYER

I'm not often in town on Saturday mornings, but when I am, my favorite place to be is with Emanuel's prayer group. What a privilege it is to be with them! Most are in person. A few join us via Zoom. I suspect some, like me, wherever I am, stop at 8:30 AM Saturdays to pray with the group from afar, neither online or in person, yet joined together across time and space through the power and presence of the Holy Spirit.

That prayer time is holy and precious time. Prayers are lifted up for friends and family and strangers. We pray for the healing of individuals, communities, creation, and our world. We pray for God's peace, strength and love to overcome divisions and to guide and protect all who care for others and who seek to be instruments of God's comfort and healing. We pray for the community of faith we call Emanuel, for council, ministry leaders, staff, our families, children and shut-ins. We pray for God's Spirit to be stirred in our midst, for Christ to be at the center of who we are and what we do, for our will to give way to God's will and God's plan for our future. Prayers are offered out loud with beautiful, almost poetic words. Other prayers are offered powerfully in silence and sighs, reminding us the "Holy Spirit intercedes (for us with God) with sighs too deep for words" (Romans 8:26).

Prayer is the most powerful resource God has entrusted to us. (James 5:16) Is there any better gift than to spend time with God who loves us and is always with us and wants the best for us? Prayer connects us to one another and to the very heart of God. (Jeremiah 29:12-13) Sometimes prayer changes my circumstances, but more often I find prayer changes ME! Prayer gives me hope, reminds me of God's love, forgiveness, presence and faithfulness. Prayer helps me know I'm not alone, despite how I might be feeling. Prayer reconnects me to the community of faith and to siblings in Christ throughout space and time and here, today, in the church. Prayer recenters me in God's presence and around God's holy purposes.

I invite you to reflect on your experience of prayer. Prayer doesn't always come easy or feel comfortable. It takes practice. And everyone has to find their own path. For some, it may be reading prayers others have written. Others pray silently, or while walking or swimming, or out loud in the car. Some write their prayers in a journal or list. Some repeatedly choose the same form of prayer while others choose variety. The truth is: how, when or where we pray, even the words we use or don't use, are not very important. What is important is that we pray, that we take time together with others and by ourselves, that we MAKE time to talk with and listen to our God who is our Perfect Parent! I can't help but wonder if 8:30 AM Saturday mornings might be a great time to start!!

In Jeremiah 29:12-13, God says, "Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart."

After learning about Jesus choosing twelve disciples, we went on a Treasure Hunt looking for the names of the 12 disciples hidden in our room. We will continue to learn more about these disciples. - •"Invisible Ball" Our amazing invisible ball allowed us to see what the Holy Spirit is like. We can't see the Holy Spirit, yet we know what the Holy Spirit does. We know the Holy Spirit works among us by what we see, hear, and know in our hearts. Galatians 5:22-23 says, "But the Spirit gives love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control."
- •"The Awesome Mosquito Bite" During this lesson, Liana helped show us that when we have a problem, whether it's a mosquito bite or a cold, or when a family member is in the hospital, that God is Lord over everything. The following previous article is perfect for what I wanted to say, but I also want to add that Stephen Ministers are here to listen to whatever is going on in your life right now. This past year and a half have been very disturbing for the best of us. It has left us wondering "what's next?"



Stephen Ministry would like to provide you with someone you can ponder those questions with, someone you can just sit and talk with, be it for an hour or two, or however long you need. We don't judge what you say, and we don't lecture on what you should do. And as always, your conversations with a Stephen Minister are confidential and are never shared. Please consider us if you want to talk.

People often ask "What exactly is a Stephen Minister?" One way to put it is that Stephen Ministers are the "After People."

Stephen Ministers are there:

- ... after the phone call you hoped you'd never get.
- ... after the funeral, when everyone has left and the emotions you've held at bay come crashing in on you.
- ... after the relationship falls apart and the bottom falls out of your life.
- ... after the doctor says, "I'm sorry, but there's nothing more we can do."
- ... after the nursing home director shakes your hand and says, "Welcome to your new home."
- ... after the last child honks the horn, waves, and drives away -- and the house suddenly seems empty.
- ... after the baby arrives, demanding more of you than you ever dreamed possible.
- ... after you find a pink slip with your final paycheck.
- ... after your family and friends have heard your story one too many times, but you still need to talk it out.

Stephen Ministers are the After People. They are ready to come alongside you and provide comfort and support for as long after as needed. Please consider letting a Stephen Minister walk with you in your time of need. Contact Pastor Sandy or call me.
