

On a survey at the end of our worship service on July 2, 80% of the respondents said that if there was one service year 'round, they would be in favor of a blended service. The respondents were from both the traditional worship service and the praise service.

Comments heard every Sunday morning since we began one service this summer have included, "isn't it nice having a fuller congregation and getting to see everybody." People who have worshipped at one service or the other in the past, have commented that the performance of the music is so good, even if the particular kind of music might not be the person's first choice.

One more observation: since we've been having one worship service which brings together two worship services, there is a feeling of vitality and life among the worshippers in the congregation. Personally, I see this during the Greeting of Peace when there is something of a peace-filled riot taking place.

Finally, I ask, what is more appealing to a visitor: a congregation of 35 or 40 people in worship, or a united congregation with double that number and a broad representation of generations present?

You might recall that the Sunday when the survey was introduced, I said that I had no agenda regarding a change to worship. I was interested in people's feelings about where we are as a congregation regarding worship in a post-covid environment. The strength of the response to coming together for blended worship was too significant to ignore. In regards to the preference for the worship time, 10 am was selected by most of the respondents.

The Church Council looked at the survey, shared other comments heard in the recent past and considered what would be best and most desirable for the congregation. It was decided to continue with our blended worship service at 10 am even after summer is over.

We all respect the fact that there are a few people who would prefer to have two services as before. We sincerely pray that you will understand the reasons for the continuation of one service and the part that the decision plays for our future ministry together at Emanuel. Feel free to address any questions or comments you might have about this decision to the church council or me.

The Sunday School offering for the last few months has been generously given for this Food Bank.


A special thanks to AJ Ward for creating this poster and flyers to share in the community, as well as sharing with the Sunday School Children.

Session Three: Needed Salvation Now—A World Wanting Wellness

Anyone who's been to a sports game knows John 3:16: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life." Lesser known is John 3:17, which states: "Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world but in order that the world might be saved ($\sigma\omega\theta\tilde{\eta}$ sōth, from the root soteria) through him." In this session, we'll explore John's commitment to service, how we as Christians see the needs of a hurting world, and how because Jesus is the bringer of salvation, we are compelled to follow Jesus into the need now.

FREE STUDY BUDDIES TUTORING RESUMES SEPTEMBER 12 TUESDAY & THURSDAY, 3-4:30 PM







Each reflective reading is accompanied by a daily scripture reference and prayer for the day that follows the Revised Common Lectionary. Booklets are available in the church entryway or office.




