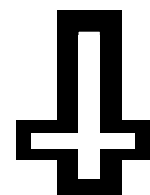

As I write this article, Trunk or Treat plans are firming up, finance people at the church have begun addressing the 2024 budget and the ministry needs of Emanuel, the Church Council decided that again this year there would be one worship service the evening of the 24th of December to celebrate Christmas Eve, (with still a regular Sunday morning worship service that day) and Study Buddies is meeting with a growing number of participants. For no need of another reason, we know it's unquestionably autumn. (Even if the temperature today is supposed to reach 91 degrees.)

We often date days or seasons by what is happening in our lives at that time. All year around there are touchstones reminding us in which month or season of the year we are alive. Sunday morning worship is another of those touchstones. We arise, we go through our morning routines, we pick a particular time to leave our home and we drive to Emanuel. At 10:00 AM we begin that solemn time we call worship. For most people it's the most intensive time of the week in our relationship with Jesus Christ. For that next hour or so, we are reminded over and over again through hymns, songs, readings and prayer, through a sermon and the Eucharist that we have a loving Lord living and nurturing our lives with his Spirit.

As I talk with other pastors about changes that they see in the church in our post-Covid world, two comments immediately surface. First, attendance is lower than before Covid hit our world. Second, and this one caught me by surprise, it is noticed that people who are attending on Sunday morning seem happier and noticeably more pleased to be present than before Covid. It seems that having been deprived of being together has brought home how important having contact with each other really is in our lives.

Seeing each other, worshipping with each other, singing hymns and songs together, sharing the greeting of peace with each other, communing with each other and fellowshiping with each other has become a new and more intense experience than it has been in the past.

Worship has become a new touchstone in our lives reminding each of us how important we are to each other, how we experience the Lord's presence in and through each other and how much richer our lives have become. If we are physically able to worship at Emanuel we add a very positive touchstone in our lives. It is in fact not really a touchstone, it is a time that unites us with Jesus Christ himself.

Trunk or Treat

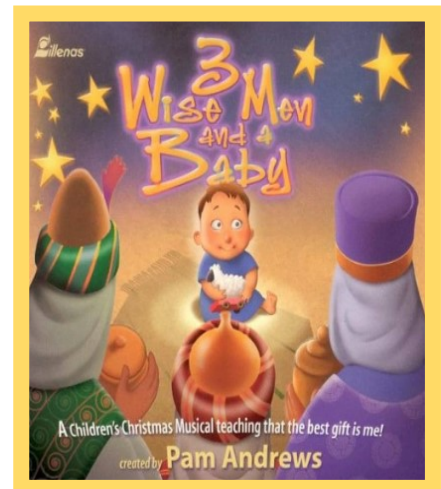

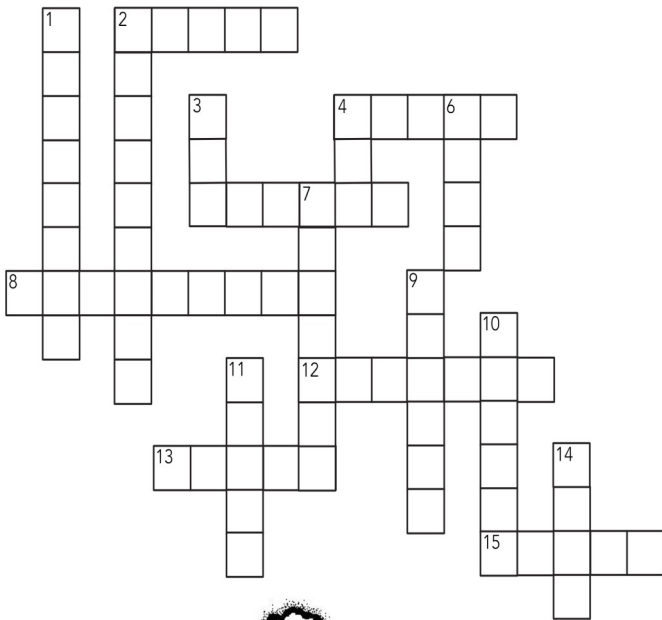
