

A NOTE FROM THE



INTERIM PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

As I write, I'm home healing and very much looking forward to being back at church and back to work. Feeling a little "off" last week, I'm thankful I took the most basic advice we've been given: Not feeling well? Stay home! After two negative tests for Covid, and a week quarantined, imagine my shock when I tested positive for Covid the morning I was set to come back to the office. Despite my disappointment, I'm very thankful for Emanuel's Covid policy and the extra testing precautions we have in place. In these challenging days, I would much rather we choose being safe and not sorry.

While being sick is not fun, having to slow down IS a tremendous opportunity to notice all the big and small ways God loves and provides for us. Thank you to everyone who has jumped in to keep worship and ministry going as several members of our worship team have had to be out due to illness. Our staff and volunteers have continued to be amazingly flexible and supportive of one another. Special thanks to Pastor Jay Egenes from Messiah Lutheran Church, Yorba Linda, who led 1/23 worship and prepared a great sermon with very little notice. What a gift to me and to our congregation.

I'm especially thankful to God for all of YOU . . . for your encouragement to rest, for fervent prayers for healing, for offers of soup or help and one of the most touching of gifts: a few calls and text messages from beloved Emanuel shut-ins checking in on me! Wow! Emanuel is by far one of the most loving and compassionate congregations I've had the privilege to serve. Love of Christ and putting others' needs ahead of your own is certainly the bedrock of Emanuel's history and heritage.

A month into 2022 I think we can all agree that the start of this new year hasn't been what any of us has expected or hoped for. It's normal to feel frustrated, disappointed and sometimes even angry as we continue to cope with so many things that are out of our control. We don't like feeling vulnerable. We may be tempted to deny what we're feeling or to blame or scapegoat ourselves or others. Scientists and doctors are doing the best they can to understand and advise us, but Covid is tricky and not always predictable. So how do we respond to the challenges?? My encouragement is that we all read and pray through Philippians 4:4-9 remembering that ***The Lord IS near!***

Breathe. Stay calm. Be gentle with yourself and others. A lot of life is not in our control. Instead of being frustrated, anxious and angry, take a deep breath. Remember God's love, presence and the peace that comes from trusting ourselves to God's care.

Make wise choices for ourselves, our families, our neighbors. Do the things that have been proven over time to make a difference. Stay home if you don't feel well. Rest. Eat well. Wash your hands. Isn't that what we've been taught since we were small children? Wearing a mask and socially distancing are important additional precautions.

Be thankful and prayerful. When you and I come before God in thankfulness and prayerfulness we are reminded that God's love for us IS bigger than any worry, any illness, bigger than any challenge facing us. Praying for others and focusing our attention on all that is worthy of praise always recenters us on God's faithfulness and providing. God IS greater than anything that might threaten our peace. How blessed we are that not only does God promise to love and be with us ALWAYS, God also promises to bring new life and hope out of our darkest moments.

I continue to give thanks for each of you and for God's love and providing for all of us.

- Visitors are always welcome!



BLOOD DRIVE — BIG THANKS!



Friendship SOUP

Make jars of Italian barley soup to share love and warmth with friends.



What you need:

- 1 cup pearled barley
- ½ cup sundried tomatoes
- 1 Tbsp dry minced garlic
- 1 Tbsp dry minced onion
- 1 veggie bouillon cube
- Glass pint jars with lids
- Cardstock
- Scissors
- Pen

What you do:


1. In order, layer the first five ingredients into the jar.
2. Trace the outline of the lid onto cardstock. Cut out.
3. On the card, write these directions: Remove wrapper from bouillon cube. Add contents of jar to saucepan. Add 4 cups water and a can of diced tomatoes. Bring to a boil over high heat, reduce to low. Simmer about 20 minutes, until barley is tender. Serve with parmesan cheese.
4. Place the card atop the lid. Screw on the canning ring to keep it in place.
