



Thanks to all who have joined our Zoom mid-week Lent worship services the last few weeks. Our Bible readings and discussion questions have invited all of us to reflect on the mission and purpose God has for us, the body of Christ here at Emanuel. That's especially important as Emanuel prepares to call a new pastor to partner in ministry with Emanuel. That's why the Transition Team has been seeking YOUR prayerful answers to the question: **What is God calling us (Emanuel) to do and to be?** In other words, **What's God's mission and purpose for us?**

Some responses they're hearing include . . . loving others as Jesus loves . . . doing the things that Jesus did . . . helping people KNOW and EXPERIENCE God's love and the gift of being part of the family of God . . . intentionally reaching out to be sure EVERYONE knows they are valued, important, welcomed and included . . . being prayerful and courageous . . . grounded in God's WORD . . . empowered by the Holy Spirit.

Notice that RELATIONSHIP is at the center of what you've said is God's mission for us. Relationship with God, with one another inside the church and ESPECIALLY relationship with those WHO DO NOT YET KNOW God's love, grace, mercy and forgiveness.

All of us know that our world is weary and in need of hope, encouragement, comfort and community. They need Jesus! They need to know God's love and presence is with them. AND, I would suggest, they need to know they can find and experience God's love and welcome here at Emanuel, one of the warmest, most generous communities of faith I've ever experienced!

Perhaps the most important AND EASIEST way for us to help others know Jesus' love is to PERSONALLY INVITE THEM or, better yet, BRING THEM WITH US TO WORSHIP !!

See the graphic I've included. 86% attend worship because of a personal invitation. Want to help Emanuel grow? Let's actually DO SOME INVITING !! And we have some great opportunities coming up...



6:30 pm Sunday, March 27 Friends of Emanuel FREE Concert

11 am – 1:30 pm Saturday, April 9 Neighborhood Easter Outreach including a FREE pizza lunch, egg hunt, crafts, stories, petting zoo. Invite others AND volunteer to help!!

9 and 10:45 worship Palm/Passion Sunday, April 10 begins with a triumphal palm procession into the Worship Center, followed by a dramatic retelling of the Passion of Our Lord. Experiencing the dramatic shift from Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem to his death on the cross helps to "set the stage" for our own Holy Week journey.

7 pm Maundy (Holy) Thursday, April 14 We'll hear how Jesus loved his followers to the end and showed us, by washing their feet, how you and I are to love one another. We'll share the Lord's Supper. We'll go to the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus is arrested and later mocked by his own people and condemned to die.

7 pm Good Friday, April 15 will find us at the foot of the cross where Jesus dies so that through his death you and I might have life and know God's love and embrace forever.

It is the journey of these last days that helps us truly experience the depth of God's love for each one of us. As our feet follow Jesus' own path to the cross and the tomb, our hearts are made ready to receive, celebrate and share with others the Good News we celebrate that not even death will separate us from God's love in Christ Jesus.

Our **Easter celebration Sunday, April 17**, will be especially blessed if we are able to include those we invite to receive and experience the GOOD NEWS of God's love made known in the empty tomb!!

April 1-15 Prayerfully Nominate Yourself or Others to Emanuel's Call Team

The Call Team is a group of 5-7 members who will guide us in seeking Emanuel's new pastor. Working with the Office of the Bishop, they will use the Mission Site Profile "MSP" (currently being put together by Emanuel's Transition Team) and will contact, interview, prayerfully consider and recommend to the Church Council and congregation the individual they believe God might be calling to partner with us in ministry. Upon council recommendation, the candidate is not called as pastor until the congregation votes to extend that call.

Your Transition Team continues, in a variety of ways, to gather your input as we help our congregation prepare to call a new pastor,:

- Mid-week Lent worship and discussion have invited everyone to prayerfully reflect on the mission and vision God might have for our community of faith.
- We're working to complete Emanuel's Ministry Site Profile (MSP). A draft will be shared with the congregation and, once approved by our Council and Synod, will guide Emanuel's Call Team.
- With Council, we've set a tentative timeline that will have the Call Team in place by early May and, God willing, we hope interviewing candidates as soon as the Synod shares them.

Thanks to our congregation members for your input and contributions toward the completion of our History and Heritage Banner Timelines. The banners will be removed from Moerer Hall and placed in the Hope Center Classroom for later viewing for our future new Pastor. They will also be used for future timeline projects.

Remember that we have only progressed up to this point of seeking a new pastor because of your prayers and support of our congregation, Church Council and Transition Team.

WINGS Shelter

With the \$1000 Matthew 25 Grant from the Pacifica Synod, we have purchased sweat shirts and sweat pants for the residents of the WINGS Shelter. By ordering directly from Hanes, we were able to purchase 30 sets of sweatshirts and sweatpants for women and 15 sets of sweatshirts and sweatpants for children for a total cost of \$1051.20. This was almost a 60% discount from the retail cost. We are so grateful to the Pacifica Synod for this grant!

YWCA – WINGS (Women in Need Growing Strong) Domestic Violence program began in 1979 and operates the second largest domestic violence shelter in Los Angeles County. WINGS' goal is to help domestic violence victims and their dependent children move out of crisis and toward safety and autonomy. They offer the community: Professional & legal assistance, Emergency Shelter, Case Management, Support groups, Educational workshops, Job development skills, Transitional Housing and Rental assistance, Youth & Teen services.

LHCRCC IS NOW THE GARY CENTER

LHCRCC is now part of the Gary Center. Gifts which have been made to LHCRCC will now be directed to the food bank at the Gary Center. They are serving and helping the same members of our community.

WE CAN DO THIS!!! Canned Tuna and Peanut Butter DRIVE

On **April 24, May 1 and May 8**, we will be making a special in-gathering of protein items for the food bank. Bring either **canned tuna or peanut butter**, as many of these items as possible to meet that need. You may recall that we have in the past provided more than 2000 cans of tuna to feed our neighbors and more than 3000 cans of soup at one time. Let's make this a wonderful opportunity to reach out to those who are hungry!

HAHO encourages you to continue to contribute non-perishable food items to the carts in the narthex, which are faithfully carried to the food bank by Ricki Fehr every week. Ricki also volunteers there packing and distributing the food. Thanks, Ricki, and thanks to all of you who help provide food to our neighbors.

We continue to support our other Emanuel ministries, as Heart and Hands Outreach interacts with almost all of them, as well as our Community-based partner ministries, and are working with Parish Ed. on Emanuel's special community outreach for Easter on April 9. Please find a way to volunteer and support our efforts!


