

We celebrate that we are a Resurrection people. We celebrate that we have new life with the Living Lord Jesus Christ. We are an Easter people. Our Sunday worship reflects that we follow Our Lord throughout the year with our praise and thanksgiving. An incredibly significant part of our worship is the opportunity to receive Communion whenever we come together.

As many of you know, it can be a challenge to locate a pastor to lead worship on a Sunday when the Called Pastor of the congregation is away. Working with Bishop David Nagler, we have arrived at a solution for Emanuel. We certainly want to be faithful to our Lutheran heritage but also offer the Holy Eucharist every Lord's Day.

Attached is a document that has been reviewed by Bishop Nagler and accepted by the Church Council of Emanuel. It is offered to you as an explanation of what to expect at times, when the pastor is unavailable on a Sunday morning. Your comments and questions are always welcome. The first Sunday when this practice will be used is May 5.

#### Eucharistic Practice at Emanuel, La Habra when no Pastor is Available to Lead Worship

Given the current shortage of pastors in the ELCA, the following procedure will be followed when a pastor is not available, in order to provide the Eucharist during Sunday worship as well as communing the sick and homebound.

The Reserved Sacrament, the use of bread and wine consecrated at an earlier worship service, is a common practice in the Episcopal Church, USA, which is a full Communion partner of the ELCA. The practice of providing the Reserved Sacrament has been in place at Emanuel for nearly nineteen years. It has been regularly used by Stephen Ministers for the Communing of care receivers. The Stephen Ministers have gone through training to properly use the sacrament in this way.

The actual practice at Emanuel on a Sunday, would take place when a Pastor is not present to Consecrate the bread and the wine. When the absence of a pastor is known ahead of time, extra bread and wine would be Consecrated at a worship service the previous week and would be stored in a secure cabinet. During the service in which the Reserved Sacrament would be used, it would be placed on the altar as usual. During the worship service, the Words of Institution would not be spoken. Distribution of Communion would take place immediately following the Lord's Prayer. A post-Communion prayer and blessing would then be offered.

To assure that the same distribution procedure would be followed at every service when the Reserved Sacrament is used, a member of the congregation, possibly a Stephen Minister, would be enlisted to lead the Communion liturgy in the worship service. The person would lead from the Prayers of Intercession to the Post-Communion Prayer.

# Good News!!!

The Roof is Coming! The Roof is Coming!

The rains this year have been wonderful for our state water needs, but less than great for our church. We thank God for the rain!

As most of you know, there have been leaks in Moerer Hall, leaks in the Hope Center (office), and leaks in the sanctuary. A variety of buckets, trash cans, and mini swimming pools have been used to collect water and perhaps a bit of ambience. Your Church Council, as well as many others, have determined that we need to take care of the roofs before the next rainy season.

A team of dedicated and hardworking people have spent the last six weeks searching for a solution. They have called numerous roofing contractors, met with four for many hours, and received bids on each building individually, all of the buildings, type of roofing, time frames, and of course, cost. After much analysis, we have determined what the best course of action is and it has been endorsed by the Church Council.

In about six to eight weeks, the contractor will begin the work. With good weather, it will take about two weeks to complete, with minimal disruption in our worship and fellowship.

Due to ongoing good financial management, we have funds in the church beautification account which will cover the cost. However, the account will be almost depleted by this necessary expenditure. Should God be calling you to assist in this project, please consider a gift to help replenish this account for future maintenance and repairs.

Thanks to Jerry Schnackenberg, John Ospital, Jack Ward, Pastor Laherty and Jeanette Parr for their diligence in this project. We also appreciate the input from James Crabb and Jeff Ward. AND



# BOOK OF ROMANS WED 9-10 AM IN THE LIBRARY




# Kid's Korner
