

Baritone Jose "Joe" Maldonado and Soprano Siveon Kim will perform at Emanuel.

It is truly a gift that Jose continues to bless Emanuel with his talent. It's a pleasure for me to think back about his involvement over the years at Emanuel.

It was ten years ago that Jose came to Emanuel to audition as a choir section leader. Although I usually didn't sit through auditions, I happened to be in the sanctuary when Stephanie had him sing to see if he would work out as a section leader. I remember hearing him sing no more than five measures of music and thinking, "Stephanie has to stop this, it would be insulting to make him go on." Just as I had that thought, she concluded the audition. He seemed incredibly qualified for the position. He added a dimension to the choir that was magnificent. Not only did he have an outstanding solo voice, but he was able to blend in with the choir as well. Not all operatic voices can do that.

Jose was with Emanuel for a couple of years before moving on to the Manhattan School of Music with his Bachelor's Degree from Cal State Fullerton. While he was in New York, he always found time during the summer, to not only visit his family in southern California, but to offer a performance at Emanuel. It's been notable that people who hear him once, return for subsequent concerts.

With his Master's from Manhattan School of Music, it was on to Michigan State University in East Lansing, Michigan to attain the level of Doctor of Music.

Before he returns this fall to Michigan State to serve on the music faculty, he and a protégé, Siveon Kim, who is enrolled in a Doctoral program at the University of Iowa, will offer a concert at Emanuel titled, "Opera Meets Hollywood". We will be blessed by these two opera professionals.

Shoes (Men's are in high demand)


Also, if you have crutches, walkers, canes, or manual wheel chairs you no longer need, they will be glad to take them. A tax donation letter is available upon request.




