

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR



Pastor Newsletter Article, October 2025

There are announcements made at Emanuel week after week regarding the various outreach that takes place from the congregation. HAHO (Hearts and Hands Outreach) monitors how each one is doing, if it fulfills the mission that it began and that it continues to be supported by the congregation. Every now and then, a new area of support is recognized and the congregation comes together to establish an outreach ministry. They are all blessings to people outside the congregation made possible by the ongoing support by the people of Emanuel. In this writing I want to bring to your attention two of the newer ministries in the last couple of years.

St. Jude's Closet is a connection Emanuel has with St. Jude Medical Center in Fullerton. For almost two years now clothing has been collected from members and given to "the closet". The idea began when the staff at St. Jude realized there were people who came through the emergency room and were inadequately clothed. In particular, during the winter people did not possess warm enough clothing. St. Jude began a program of collecting clothing. Rather quickly they realized that the need was greater than the supply. Emanuel entered the program just before Christmas of 2023. Numerous jackets and other articles of clothing were delivered to St. Jude. This practice has continued year 'round. The appreciation of St. Jude will be shown when on the first Sunday in October, Ms. Giovanna Lara, the Community Care Navigator of St. Jude, will be coming to Emanuel to offer thanks on behalf of St. Jude. In the end it is a clear statement; your giving really matters and makes a difference in people's lives.

Burrito Ministry has been preparing burritos and delivering them to hungry people for nearly six months now. On the third Saturday of the month at 10:00am, the rice is started and the chicken begins to simmer. By 11:00am, fifteen or so burritos are ready to deliver to people in need of nourishment and a prayer. There are the regular participants who come together. There are those who prepare the burritos and those who deliver them. The deliverers take off from the church and look for people on sidewalks or parking lots who seem to be without a home. Some Saturdays there are a number of people in whatever direction we head. On other Saturdays there don't seem to be as many. This past Saturday for example, the deliverers drove to a transportation center at Magnolia and Orangethorpe. There were fifteen people there who were clearly eager to be blessed with a burrito and a prayer. You never know exactly what to expect except that the need for providing food for the hungry continues and so does the burrito ministry.

We do ask that you stay within the list as we've received some items that we weren't able to take such as dresses, women's shorts/skirts, and children's clothes. 


FREE STUDY BUDDIES TUTORING TUESDAY & THURSDAY, 3-4:30 PM





Why do stars appear to twinkle? Try this experiment to find out!

What you need:

- Aluminum foil
- Large glass bowl
- Flashlight



What you do:

- 1. Crumple the foil into a ball. Carefully unfold it and lay it flat on the ground.
- 2. Fill the bowl with water and place it on the foil.
- 3. Turn off the lights and make the room as dark as possible. Shine the flashlight about 1 foot from the water's undisturbed surface. Light will reflect onto the foil.
- 4. Then tap your finger on the water's surface. As the water moves, what happens to the light on the foil?
- This flickering simulates scintillation, which happens when starlight enters Earth's atmosphere. As light passes through layers of gas and water, it refracts and appears to twinkle.
